Groundwater is Vulnerable

Pennsylvania's groundwater supplies are at risk from a variety of human activities that can negatively affect both groundwater quantity and quality. This threat to our groundwater comes at a time when we in Pennsylvania are becoming more dependent on this resource for several reasons.

Although the state has experienced only minimal population growth during the past few decades, there has been a steady migration of people and industry from the cities to more rural settings. This has resulted in the development of groundwater resources at a rate three times that of surface water.

The development of groundwater resources has also accelerated due to concern about the quality of surface water and to the expense of new federal regulations requiring increased filtration of surface water used for drinking.

Although the public has become used to seeing the federal and state governments take the lead in environmental protection, when it comes to groundwater protection, the initiative and responsibility in Pennsylvania lies with local communities and their leaders. Therefore, as the threat to groundwater grows along with our dependence on it, protecting our valuable groundwater supplies must become a priority for local governments.
