Technical Specifications

General Description

A traditional proscenium theatre with extension and false proscenium (masking flats) to create full DS of curtain line with exits SR & SL.

A total of 250 seats (180 raked).

Lighting booth located in back of house on CL, with full view of stage.

Two (2) dressing rooms located off SL to accommodate 10-15 people each. Both are equipped with toilets, hot and cold sinks, and makeup mirrors with lighting.
