## Cranberry Creek Preserves

**Nothstein Preserve** Over 100 acres with wild trout catch and release fishing.

**Upper Paradise Preserve** 230 acres owned and managed by Pocono Heritage Land Trust with hunting and wild trout catch and release fishing.

Henry's Crossing Preserve 250 acres owned and managed by Pocono Heritage Land Trust. Links Upper Paradise Preserve with Paradise Price Preserve across the road with hunting and wild trout catch and release fishing.

Paradise Price Preserve 777 acres straddling the watershed ridge of the two townships with hunting and wild trout catch and release fishing encouraged. View of Targa Falls on Brodhead Creek on Price Township side.

Van Buskirk Farm Preserve 86 acres including one-third mile of the Cranberry Creek and downstream of Nothstein Preserve. Public access limited, access under development.

# Paradise Headwater Preserves

Kurmes Paradise Creek Preserve
400 acres owned and managed by Pocono
Heritage Land Trust. Paradise Creek
begins in the heart of this preserve at the
confluence of Tank Creek and Yankee
Run. Two marked trails on property.
Scenic views with hunting and wild trout
catch and release fishing.

Yankee Run Preserve. 63 acres owned and managed by Pocono Heritage Land Trust. Streamside trails under development. Wild trout catch and release fishing.

Fieldstone Farm Tank Creek Preserve 52 acres owned and managed by Pocono Heritage Land Trust. Views, streamside trails under development, historic stone farmhouse remains. Hunting and wild trout catch and release fishing.

### **PARC**

**Ice Lake Area** 65-acre preserve located in neighboring Barrett Township with small manmade lake. Walking, contemplation, birding.

**Skywood Park** 55-acre regional park with picnic table. Stunning view of Delaware Water Gap and excellent viewpoint for raptor migrations. Fitness circuit. Sledding hill and ice skating in winter.

**Seven Pines Park** 17-acre regional park with baseball fields, picnic tables.

# Mt. Airy Trail Network

Woodland Road Trail Easy out-and-back trail along Forest Hills Run. Hiking, creek views.

Merry Hill Trail Moderate loop trail through several habitats and a picnic table near small pond.

Red Rock Trail Multi-branched loop trail with vernal pools, some steep climbs and a picnic table.

Wiscasset Pond Trail Easy handicap accessible out-and-back trail to a small pond with waterfowl and other wildlife and a gazebo.

The Roof Paradise Township park for active recreation including baseball fields, basketball courts, playground and picnic pavilion. To reserve the pavilion, call 595-9880 extension 3. Fishing is wild trout catch and release encouraged.

Little Park Adjacent park to Paradise Creek with baseball field, playground, benches and picnic tables.

**Posie's Park** Pocket park near the Municipal Building. Gazebo and native plant garden.

**Knauf Farm Preserve** 35-acre Paradise Township preserve with wetlands and small creek.

Swiftwater Forest Preserve 98-acre wooded parcel on both sides of Donaldson Road with parking available at cul-de-sac and trails under development.


**The Knob** 34-acre preserve owned by neighboring Mount Pocono Borough. One of the best views in the area, great place to see summer meteor showers.
