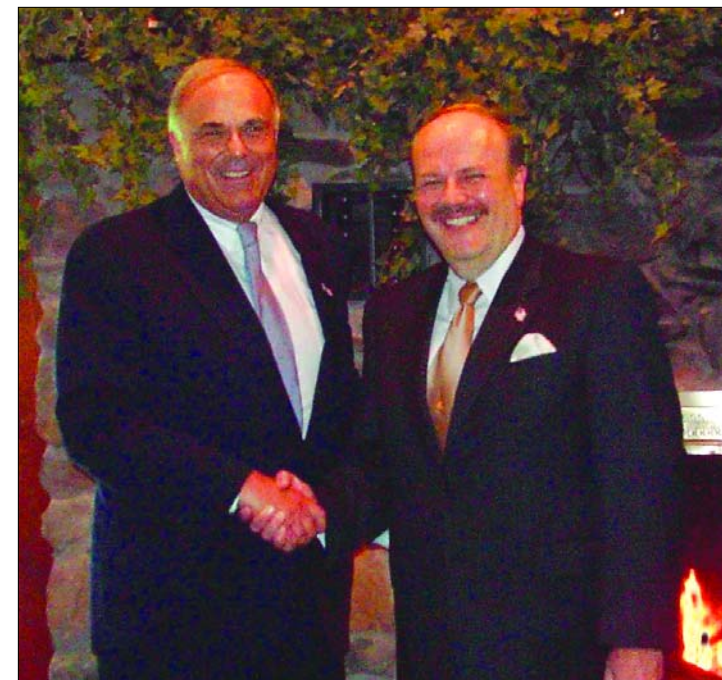
## THE CHAMBER WELCOMES GOVERNOR ED RENDELL

A lunch sponsored by the Pocono Mountains Chamber of Commerce for Pennsylvania Governor Ed Rendell was held on Thursday June 17, 2004 at Stroudsmoor Country Inn. More than 300 local leaders attended the luncheon to hear Governor Rendell summarize his job creating and economic stimulus package, which recently received overwhelming bipartisan approval from the General Assembly.

The Governor outlined the various stimulus programs and how they will address the area's needs for an infrastructure that will support business and new investment that will help to create and retain jobs. He also commented on how important tourism is to Monroe County's economy comparing it to agriculture as being one of Pennsylvania's two largest industries.

“I want businesses in Monroe County and throughout the Commonwealth to take notice--through the various economic stimulus programs, I will do everything I can to support public and private sector growth while maintaining a keen focus on creating and retaining jobs,” said Governor Rendell. “We not only have a plan for a New Pennsylvania, but the tools we need to build it together.”

The Governor explained that by leveraging more than \$2 billion in grants, guarantees, and loans over the next three years, the economic stimulus plan will generate an additional \$5 billion in private-sector

investment to help start new businesses throughout the Commonwealth as well as helping existing companies to expand.

“We are very pleased that Governor Rendell accepted the Chamber's invitation to speak at this luncheon,” said Chamber President/CEO Robert P. Phillips. “The economic-stimulus package is a capable new plan that is designed to help Pennsylvania to be more competitive in today's economic climate.”

On June 17 2004, the Pocono Mountains Chamber of Commerce arranged a luncheon for Pennsylvania Governor Edward G. Rendell. This historic Chamber event, attended by 300 local leaders, was accommodated through the gracious and elegant hospitality of Andy and Linda Forte of Stroudsmoor Country Inn.

Governor Rendell came to Monroe County to present a summarization of his new economic-stimulus plan that was recently accepted and approved by the Commonwealth's General Assembly. This plan was designed with the goal of stimulating economic growth, creating jobs, and developing a method to increase job retention. The entire sum of \$2 billion dollars will be leveraged by the state over the course of the next three years; it is estimated that it will generate an additional \$5 billion in private industry investment. With an estimate of more than \$7 billion dollars to be used for new business ventures and existing business expansions, the state of Pennsylvania is poised to be a leader in economic growth. Economic experts have asserted that this plan is one of the most comprehensive economic stimulus packages in the United States.

When I learned that Governor Rendell had accepted my invitation to make a personal visit to Monroe County, I was honored. Your Chamber will be working in conjunction with other local organizations and authorities to apply for funding for Monroe County. Any funds awarded to us would be used to enhance our county's programs, and to extend benefits that will promote our region's economic and business growth. I would like to personally thank Governor Rendell for his recent visit to our area and for providing our members with a greater insight into this impressive economic stimulus plan.

The Governor's visit demonstrates another fine example of your membership benefits. The Pocono Mountains Chamber of Commerce is *the* leader, your advocate for business, and a supportive community partner.
